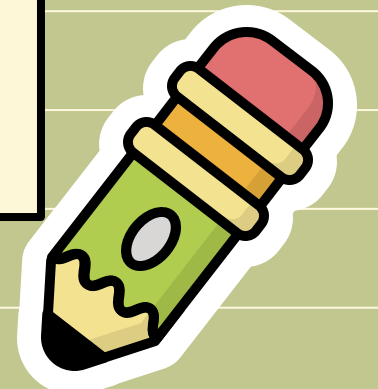
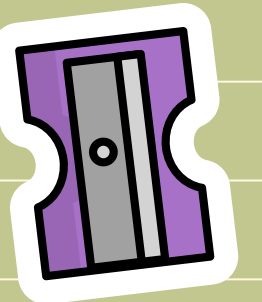

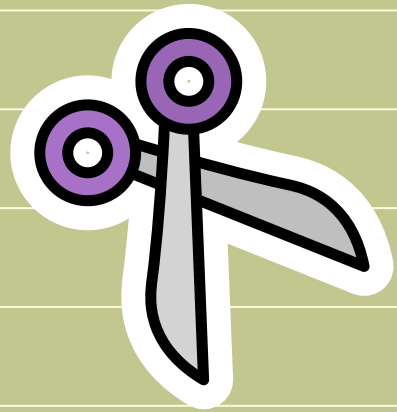

Applying to the District 30 3K/Pre-K Centers and Kindergarten

WHEN to APPLY: Kindergarten deadline is January 19, 2024. 3K and Pre-K applications open on January 10, 2024.

HOW to APPLY to 3K/Pre-K:

If your child was born in 2021 and not yet in school:

1. Create an account on [myschools.nyc](https://www.myschools.nyc.gov)
2. Apply to up to 12 3K programs in order of preference.

If your child was born in 2020, whether your child is currently attending school, or not yet enrolled in school:

1. Create an account on [myschools.nyc](https://www.myschools.nyc.gov)
2. Apply to up to 12 Pre-K programs in order of preference.

How Kindergarten G&T Offers Are Made:

- After your application is submitted, eligibility is determined by the DOE and eligible applicants will be notified in Spring 2024.
- Offers are determined based on families' application choices, seat availability, and admissions priorities. All G&T programs give priority to eligible siblings of current students.

What You Can Do at Home:

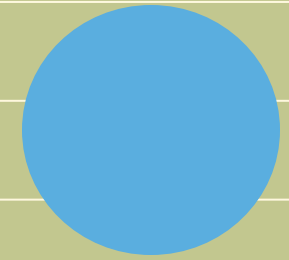
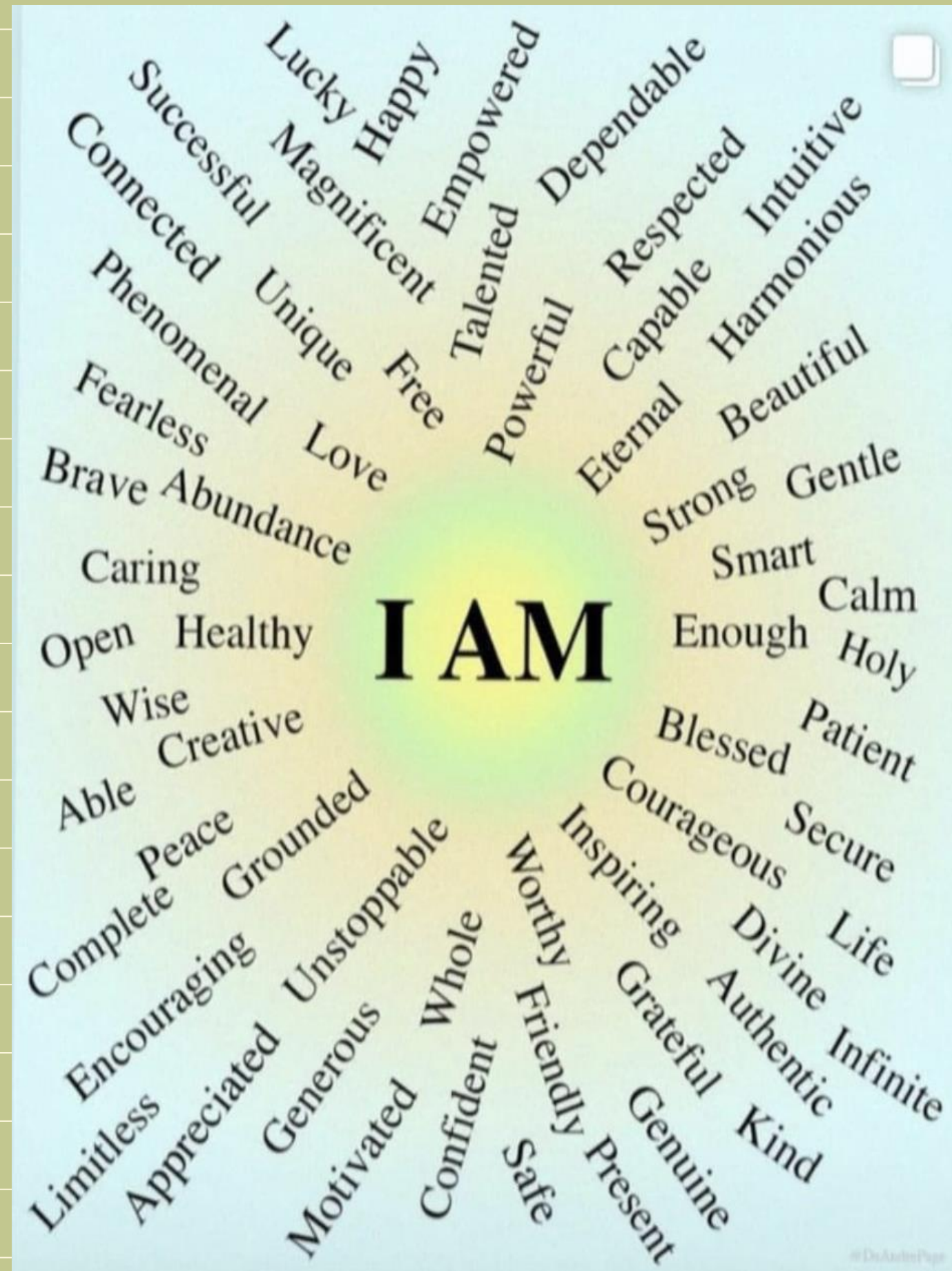
- Share with your child ways they can reuse items they have at home.

If your child was born in 2019, is a current Pre-K student at a NYCDOE school, charter school, private or parochial school program or if your child is not yet in school:

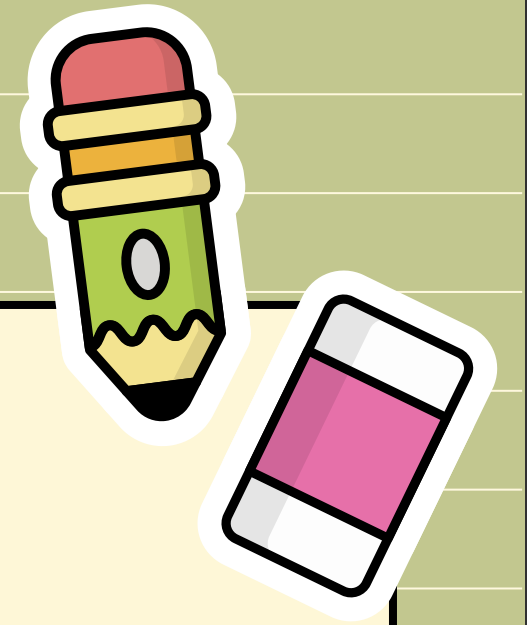

3. You may choose to list a Gifted and Talented program on your child's Kindergarten application.

3. Social Perceptiveness and Self-Direction:

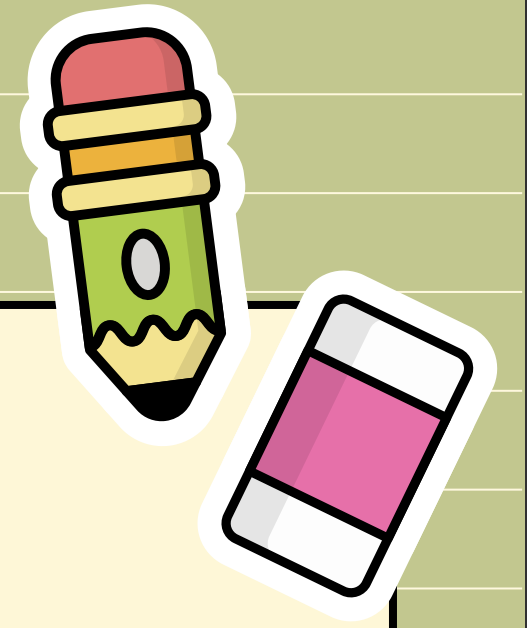
Listens to peers with empathy and understanding
