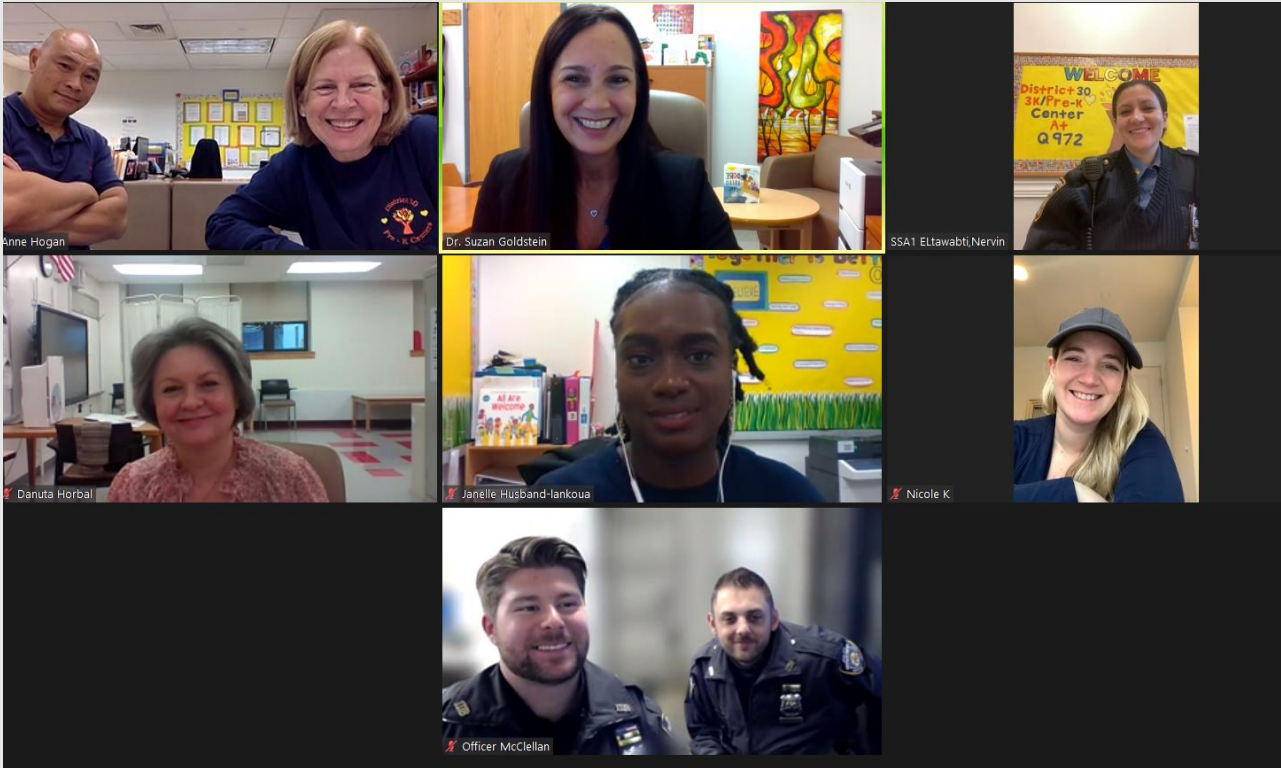
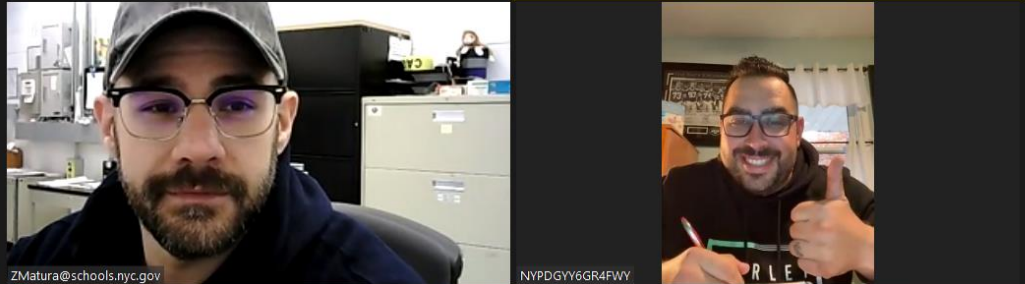
### Ways the Book can be Used in the Classroom

- Students create a class book on how to have friends

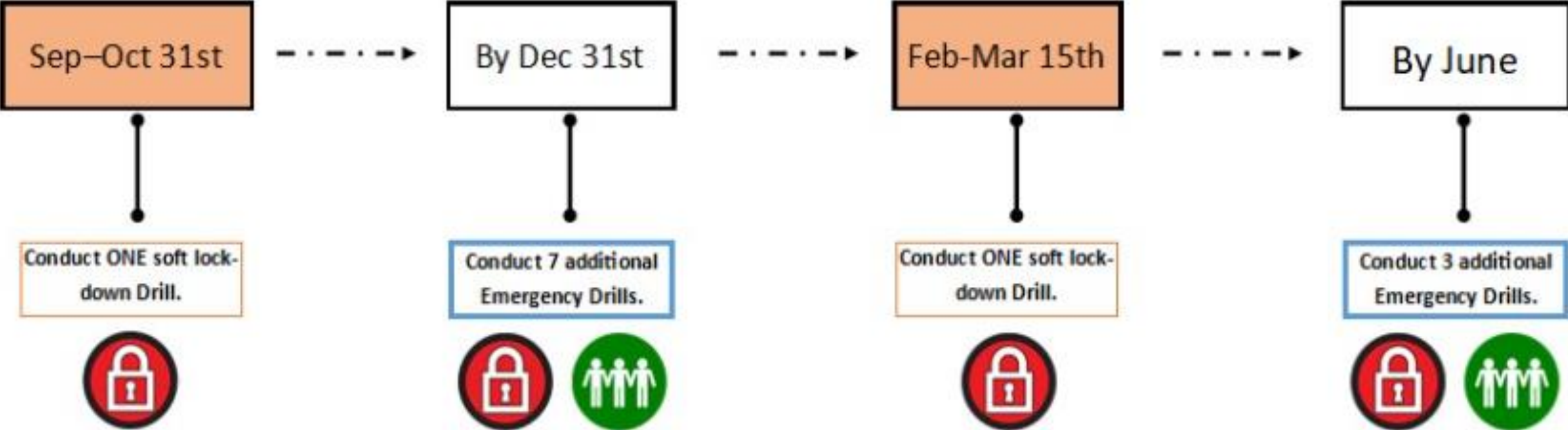



# Google Classrooms

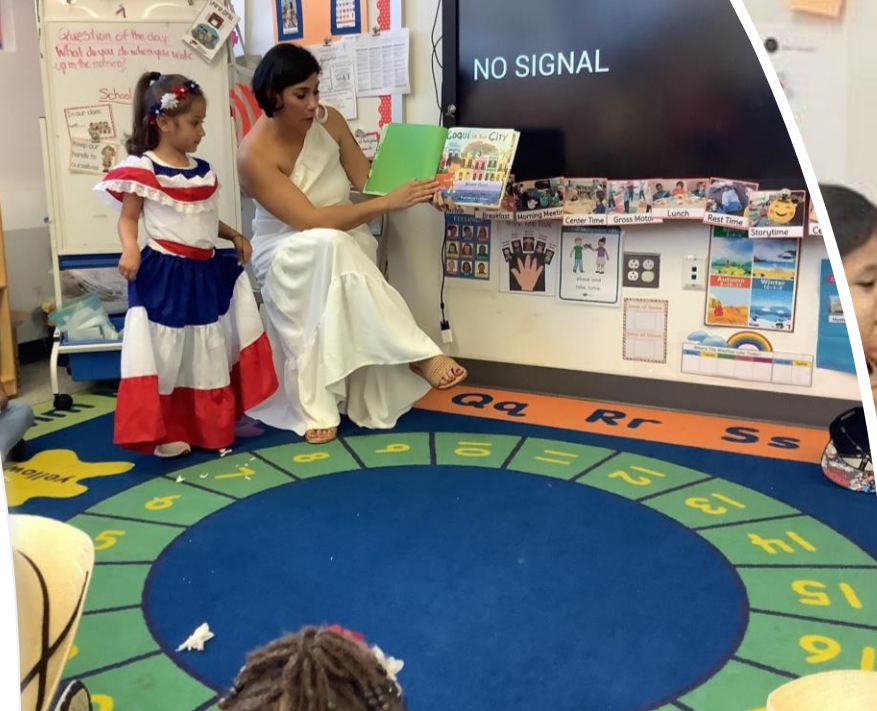
- Please make sure you create a NYCSA account. You will need a creation code. Please reach out to your child's teacher if you did not receive this.
